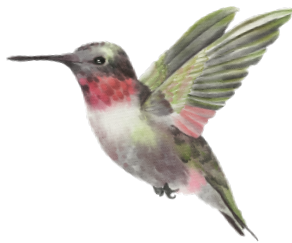
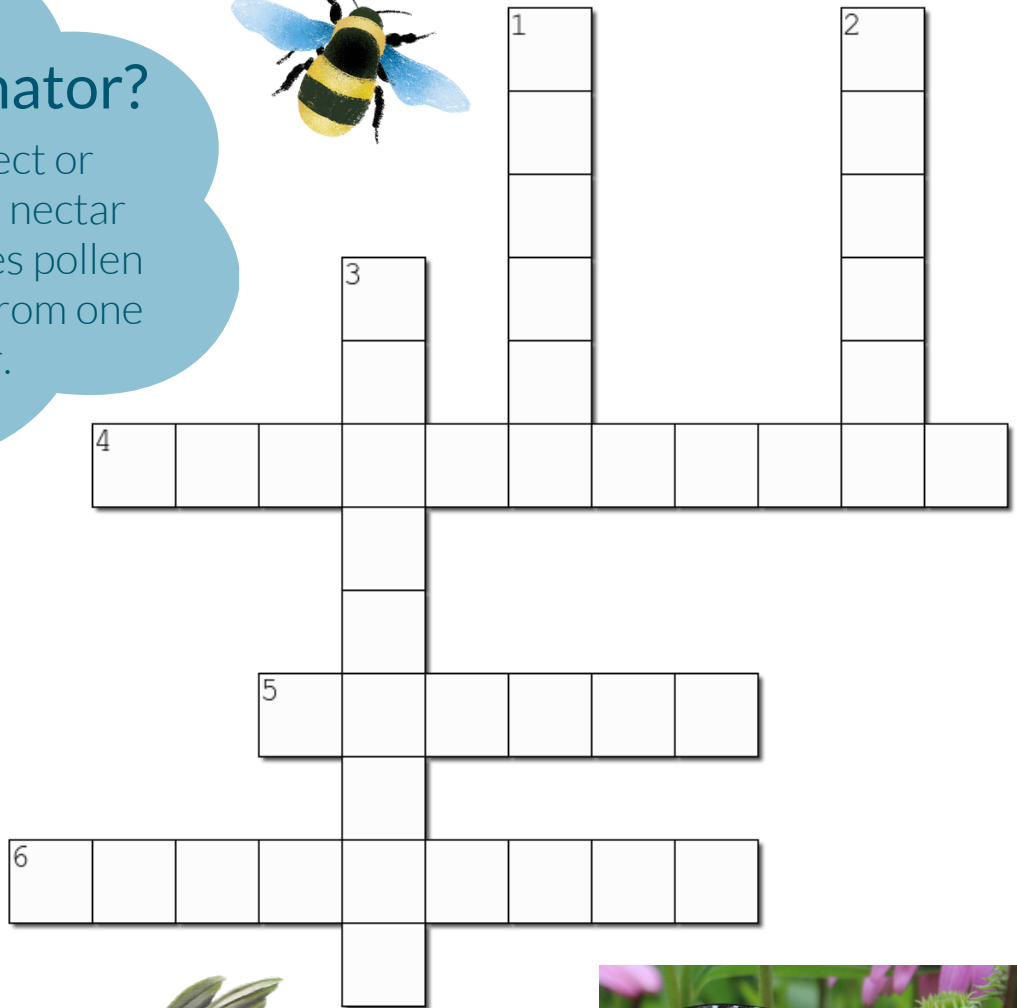
What is a pollinator?
