Nest in sand or gravel bottoms and enjoy shallow water with lots of vegetation for protection from predators and strong currents.

Live near spawning beds made of rock because they can safely lay their eggs in the spaces between the rocks.

Lay their eggs on natural woody debris and vegetation to improve their spawning success and abundance.

Prefer areas of the water that are shaded by tall trees and large weeds I because it makes the water cooler.

Build nests near brush bundles as this place to rest and hide from predators.
